After the end of Napoleon's rule Europe was left in ruins and the 1800's became a century filled with political, industrial and ideological changes.

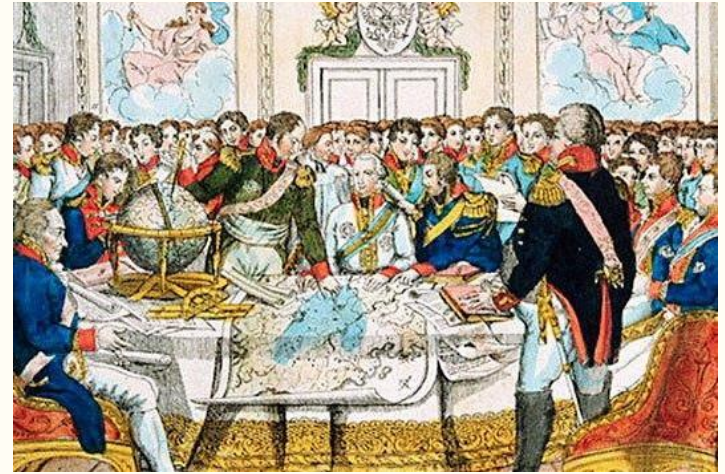
These changes together with industrialization and the rise of feminism will be discussed to achieve an overview of the 1800's.

- Two new systems of alliances formed
 - Holy alliance
 - Quadruple alliance



An Era of Revolutions, Early 1800's

1820's

- Liberals and nationalists revolted
- Greek independence (1830)

1830's

- July revolution
- Belgian independence from the dutch
- Revolts failed in central Europe

Revolt in Spain → Reinstated liberal constitution → More revolutions

July ordinances → July revolution → Constitutional monarchy (France)

Austrian and Prussian conservatives repressed liberals
